

## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER



## TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257

## THE ASHFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH AE210 (PART), BOUGHTON ALUPH PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2011

On 07 June 2011 the Ashford Borough Council confirmed the above Order Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the entire width of that length of public footpath numbered AE210 which commences at its junction with Trinity Road (A251) at NGR TR 00780 45178 (Point A) and runs in a west north westerly direction for 544 metres to its connection with the farm access track and the unaffected section of public footpath AE210 at NGR 00265 45363 (Point B) and provide a new length of public footpath numbered AE210, which commences at a new junction with Trinity Road (A251) at NGR TR 00740 45122 (Point C). At this point there is a kissing gate situated on the Science Park boundary. The path runs in a west north westerly direction for 48 metres to NGR TR 00698 45144 (Point D) where it passes onto the raised linear park and continues to run in a generally west north westerly direction for 66 metres. The path then turns to run in a north westerly, through west north westerly direction for 180 metres, thence west south westerly for 70 metres to NGR TR00436 45272 (Point E), where the path leaves the raised linear park. The path continues in a west south westerly direction for 93 metres to the boundary hedge at NGR TR 00345 45259 (Point F), where it passes through a 1 metre gap in the hedge. The path then turns to run in a north north westerly direction for 133 metres - along the western side of the boundary hedge - to a new connection with the farm access track at NGR TR 00298 43282 (Point G). At this point there is a kissing gate on the field boundary. The path then turns to run in a west south westerly direction - along the access track - for 36 metres its connection with the unaffected section of public footpath AE210 at NGR TR 00265 45363 (Point B). As shown on the Order Plan.

All directions general, all distances approximate.

The Order comes into force on the date on which Kent County Council – on behalf of Ashford Borough Council – certify that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under Section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within six weeks of the date on which Notice is first published as required by paragraph (7) (8) of Schedule 14 to that Act.
