THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under section 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47 and 124 and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004, the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act, hereby make the following Order:-

AMENDMENTS

1. The Kent County Council (Various Roads, Borough of Ashford) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2007 as amended is hereby amended as follows:-

In the Schedules to the Order:

- 2. In the First Schedule Part 1 STREET OR LENGTH OF STREET WHERE WAITING IS PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME:
- (a) The following item to be inserted:

Lengths of Road in Ashford in the Borough of Ashford

BROADHURST DRIVE

- (1) On both sides from a point 4.9 metres north-east of a point in line with the south-western building line of No. 252 Faversham Road extending in a north-easterly direction to its junction with Faversham Road.
- (b) The following item to be replaced:

Lengths of Road in Ashford in the Borough of Ashford

FAVERSHAM ROAD

- (1) On the eastern side;
- (a) from a point in line with the south-western kerb line of Nettlefield extending in a south-westerly direction for a distance of 20.0 metres.
- (b) from a point in line with the north-eastern kerb line of Nettlefield extending in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 14.0 metres.
- (c) from a point 20.0 metres south of a point in line with the centre line of Burton Road extending in a northerly direction to its junction with Burton Road.
- (d) from a point 24.0 metres north of a point in line with the centre line of Burton Road extending in a southerly direction to its junction with Burton Road.
- (e) from a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 99 & 101 Faversham Road extending in a generally northerly direction to its junction with Church Road.
- (f) from a point 46.0 metres south-east of a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 175 & 177 Faversham Road extending in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Church Road

- (g) from a point 0.2 metres south-east of a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 175 & 177 Faversham Road extending in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 24.6 metres.
- (h) from a point 16.0 metres south-east of a point in line with and opposite the south-eastern kerb line of The Pasture extending in a north-westerly direction to a point 19.3 metres north-west of a point in line with and opposite the north-western kerb line of The Pasture.
- (i) from a point 63.0 metres south-east of a point in line with the south-eastern kerb line of Upper Vicarage Road extending in a north-westerly direction to a point 25.0 south-east and opposite a point in line with the north-western building line of No. 210 Faversham Road.
- (j) from a point 30.2 metres north-west of a point in line with the north-western building line of No. 210 Faversham Road extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Upper Vicarage Road.
- (k) from a point in line with the northern kerb line of Upper Vicarage Road extending in a north-westerly direction to a point 38.2 metres south-east of a point in line with the north-western building line of The Rose Inn PH.
- (I) from a point 6.9 metres south-east of a point in line with the north-western building line of The Rose Inn PH extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Ulley Road.
- (m) from a point 2.7 metres north-west of a point in line with and opposite the north-western building line of Orchard Cottage, Faversham Road extending in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Ulley Road.
- (2) On the western side;
- (a) from a point 21.5 metres south-west of a point in line with and opposite the south-western kerb line of Nettlefield extending in a north-easterly, northerly then north-westerly direction to a point 2.4 metres north-west of a point in line with the common boundary of Nos. 120 & 122 Faversham Road.
- (b) from a point 56.0 metres south-east of a point in line with the south-eastern kerb line of Park Road extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Park Road.
- (c) from a point 18.5 metres north-west of a point in line with the north-western kerb line of Park Road extending in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Park Road.
- (d) from a point 56.0 metres north-west of a point in line with the north-western kerb line of Park Road extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with The Pasture.
- (e) From a point 11.8 metres south-east of a point in line with the north-western building line of No. 210 Faversham Road extending in a south-easterly direction to its junction with The Pasture.
- (f) from a point 30.2 metres north-west of a point in line with the north-western building line of No.210 Faversham Road extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Lower Vicarage Road.
- (g) from a point 24.7 metres south-east of a point in line with and opposite the north-western building line of No. 231 Faversham Road extending in a south-westerly direction to its junction with Lower Vicarage Road.
- (h) from a point 6.8 metres north-west of a point in line with and opposite the north-western building line of No. 231 Faversham Road extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Broadhurst Drive.

- (i) from its junction with Broadhurst Road extending in a north-westerly direction to a point 17.9 metres south-east of a point in line with and opposite the north-western building line of The Rose Inn PH.
- (j) from a point 13.8 metres north-west and opposite a point in line with and opposite the north-western building line of The Rose Inn PH extending in a north-westerly direction to its junction with Grosvenor Road.
- (k) from a point 2.7 metres north-west of a point in line with the north-western building line of Orchard Cottage, Faversham Road extending in a south-easterly direction to its junction with Grosvenor Road.


STATEMENT OF REASONS
