SANDYHURST LANE, ASHFORD

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow repair works to be carried out following earlier water excavations, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Sandyhurst Lane, Ashford.

A closure is planned from Thursday 12 March 2020, with estimated completion by 16 March 2020.

Sandyhurst Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of number 148, roughly mid-way along.

Local access to the remainder of Sandyhurst Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A20 Maidstone Road, Drivers Roundabout, Fougères Way, Junction 9 Interchange, A251 Trinity Road and Faversham Road back to Sandyhurst Lane.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network – [South East Water Permit EB00620124087], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
