**SANDYHURST LANE &
A20 MAIDSTONE ROAD, ASHFORD**

(TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2014

Because of gas mains replacement works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit all traffic on part of Sandyhurst Lane, Ashford and impose a 40 mph limit on a section of the A20 Maidstone Road, Ashford.

Revised restrictions have been introduced for the safety of the public and workforce. These take effect from Monday 7 July 2014 with an estimated completion date of 11 August 2014.

Sandyhurst Lane will be closed to all traffic at the junction with A20 Maidstone Road, so there will be no access between the A20 and Sandyhurst Lane.

The alternative route is via the remainder of Sandyhurst Lane, A251 Faversham Road, Trinity Road, A20 Junction 9 Interchange, Fougères Way and Drivers Roundabout to Maidstone Road, and *vice versa* in reverse.

A temporary mandatory speed limit of 40 mph will apply on A20 Maidstone Road, on the coast-bound carriageway (towards Ashford) from a point level with the western entrance to the large lay-by just west of Sandyhurst Lane, extending south-eastwards to the existing 40 mph speed limit sign.

This will be indicated by 40 mph signage displayed on site.

Due to the nature of these works, all restrictions will continue to remain in force outside the working hours.
