Ashford Local Plan to 2030: Site Submissions

The new local plan will need to identify sufficient land to provide for any new jobs and homes to 2030, as well as for Gypsy & Traveller's sites, Leisure, Retail, Visitor and Tourism facilities. One of our aims will be to establish which sites within the borough, could be suitable to allocate for these future developments and facilities.


Between July and September, we requested that people send in to us details of any sites that were available for development. We received a total of 168 submissions, 30 in Town and the urban areas and 138 in Tenterden and the rural area.

107 of these sites were submitted for Housing, 43 for employment and mixed use, 7 for tourist, community or leisure uses only and 12 for Gypsy and Traveller sites.


